



PAA Fly Neighbourly Policy

Commitment

The Porepunkah Airfield Association (PAA) is committed to managing the Porepunkah Airfield for the benefit of users whilst maintaining safety and a positive relationship with neighbours in the Buckland Valley and the Alpine Shire who own the airfield.

Scope

This policy relates to flying activities around Porepunkah Airfield and sensitivity to noise

Operating Hours

Normal aircraft operations from 8 AM (Sunday 9 AM) up to 8 PM.

Departures prior to 8am (Sunday 9am) are allowable but must be away from the airfield and the valley to reduce noise and should not return before normal operation times.

No continuous circuits. No continuous engine test runs permitted outside normal operating hours.

Noise Sensitive Areas

Noise sensitive areas exist around the airfield. Late downwind and base legs for both RWY 36 and 18 are particularly sensitive. Normal circuit heights must be adhered to. For further information refer to website www.ypok.org.au.
